### **“METERING FOR A BETTER EXPOSURE”**

Janet’s interest in photography started in the 1950’s and 1960’s when she took many family photos with her first camera, a Brownie Hawkeye. Her serious pursuit of photography began in earnest in 1975 while her husband, Bill, was stationed in Germany. She bought a Mamiya C330 Twin lens medium format camera and spent many hours in the black & white darkroom at the post recreation center. For three years, she honed many black and white film developing and printing techniques.

Janet and her family moved to Okemah in 1988. At that time, she launched a photography business from her home where she focuses on high school senior portraiture, but also shoots memory mates for team sports and dances, family portraits, class reunions, with an occasional wedding and some commercial work. She also teaches photographic workshops through the local public schools and area art programs in pinhole photography, cyanotype printing, and digital photography. In 1991, Janet graduated from Oklahoma State University, Okmulgee Branch with an Associates Degree in Photography, and immediately after graduation, she taught two semesters of photography at OSU Okmulgee.

She graduated from East Central University in 1995 where she earned a Bachelor of Science Degree in Art Education with a Minor in Studio Art.

Being a member of the Metro Camera Club has encouraged her to pursue her interests in landscape, still-life, and macro photography. “I strive to shoot photographs that let people view everyday or common subjects in a new light.”

Janet won the top award in the Metro Camera Club, the “Charles Cameron Award” for 2009.

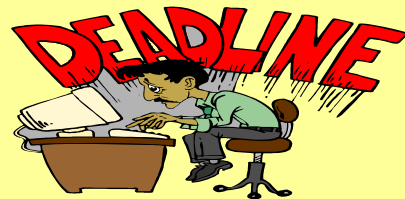

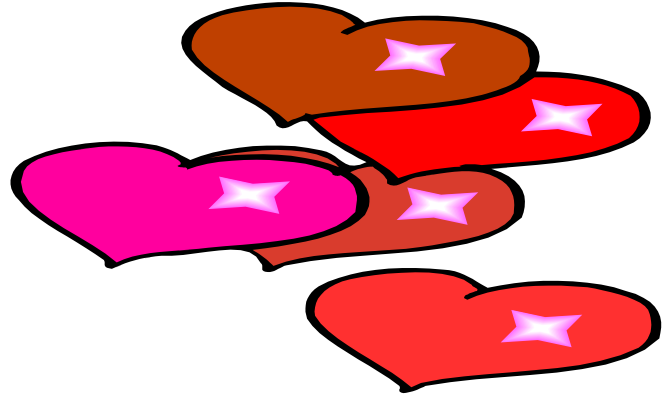

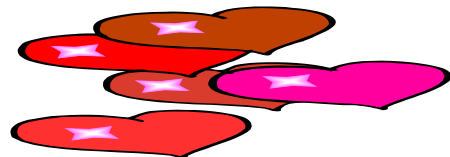
