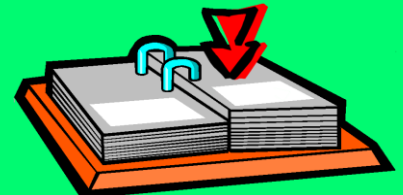

Ted Lane will be providing instruction for portrait lighting and posing.

Additional lighting set-ups will be provided by members of the Metro Camera Club. Mr. Lane will begin portrait instruction promptly at 10:00 AM until noon. During lunch and until 3:00 PM members and guests will be encouraged to use the same equipment used during the lecture to practice the art of portrait photography.

Lighting Workshop – Table Top Lighting

Janet Steyer will be setting up 3 different sets this year.

One of those sets will be a fairly inexpensive way to shoot water drops. Anyone interested in this technique should have a camera that will set to a high ISO of approx. 2000, a high shutter speed of approx. 1/4000s, and be able to shoot bursts of multiple shots of 10-15.

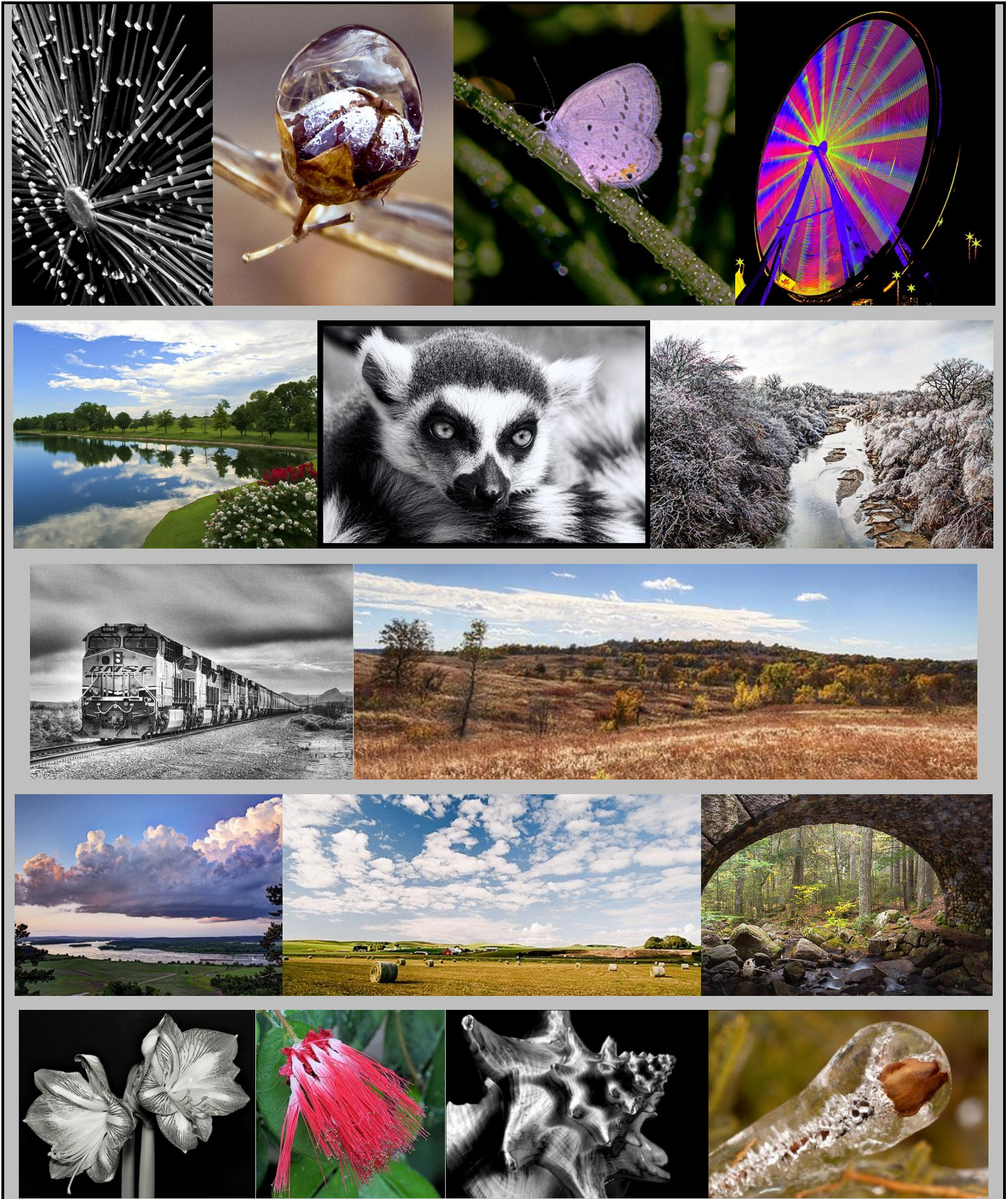

Bret Weston Show – OKC Museum of Art



In celebration of a recent gift from Christian Keesee of 150 photographs by the noted American photographer Brett Weston, the Oklahoma City Museum of Art is organizing "Brett Weston: Land, Sea, and Sky, Recent Gifts from the Christian Keesee Collection" to be on view from March 15 to June 1.

The exhibition will include examples from 1940 to 1985, and consist predominantly of mud, rock, and ice abstractions, in addition to examples highlighting Brett's travels to Baja California, Michigan, Florida, Alaska, Mexico, and Japan.

"The Oklahoma City Museum of Art is honored to have received 150 photographs over the past three years from the Christian K. Keesee Collection," said Oklahoma City Museum of Art President and CEO E. Michael Whittington in a news release. "Brett Weston's photographs form an important part of the Museum's growing photography collection and we are excited to expand our holdings of this important photographer's work and now share it during this outstanding exhibition."
