Submit your best four pictures for each category. Entries will be accepted at the May 24th meeting on digital media or on the website at webmaster@metrocameraclub.org until midnight May 24th. Results will be shown and discussed at the meeting on June 14th. Submissions should be sized to the same criteria as for Digital Projected Images.

Entries should be named according to the convention for Digital Projected Images using all capital letters and comma separation - begin with DTH so we know it goes to this competition, follow with the category, A for spring, B for Blue, C for Selective focus, then Image Title, last name, first name. Use commas to separate the fields. So an entry for Spring would look like:

DTH,A,MY FAVORITE PICTURE OF SPRING,LASTNAME,FIRSTNAME

There is no pre-entry, no limitations as to how many images you make, or numbering for the entries; make as many images as you want for each category and submit your best **FOUR** in each category.

Images should adhere to the same processing standards as the regular Digital projected Images competition; you can dodge and burn, sharpen, and adjust contrast and brightness.

OFFICER ELECTION

1. Election of Club officers shall be held annually. The President in September shall appoint a Nominating Committee composed of three members not on the Executive Board. Any member of the Executive Board shall not attend the Committee meetings. The Committee shall prepare a full slate of officers and directors and obtain the agreement of the nominees to serve if elected. The Chairman shall present the slate at the first meeting in October.

2. Elections will be held the first meeting in November.

3. No officer can be elected to the same post for more than two consecutive terms.

4. The President, subject to the approval of the Executive Board, shall fill vacancies in Club offices. Vacancy of the President's office shall be filled by the advancement of the vice-president.

5. Newly elected officers shall assume their duties at the beginning of the Club's fiscal year. The fiscal year of the Club shall be from January 1 to December 31.

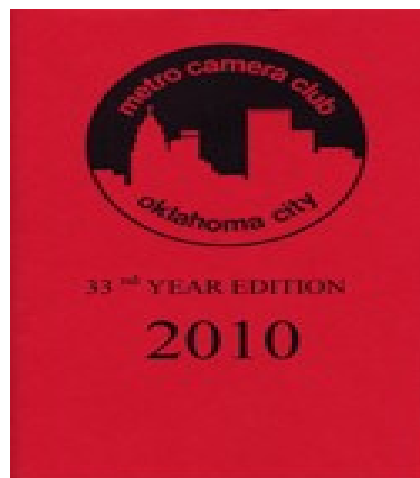
