## A Bit of Photographic History



### The Daguerreotype in America

The Daguerreotype introduced to the world in 1839 as the earliest common form of photography is the first of three processes which all produced unique and mirrored or reversed images. The medium for daguerreotype normally is a sheet of copper with one side washed with silver. The silver side was then made light sensitive by heating it over iodine. The sensitized plate was then exposed like a negative in a film camera. Processing the exposed plate involved two steps: 1. The plate was developed by exposure to mercury vapor, and 2. the development stopped by "fixing" the plate with salt. Then to keep the plate and its image from tarnishing, daguerreotypes would be sandwiched into a box case, so that when you opened the case you viewed the daguerreotype through a sheet of glass supported above the daguerreotypes by a gilded brass mat or border.. By taping the edges of the stacked daguerreotypes mat and cover glass with a non-porous tape and protecting the edge tape with a thin brass cover called the "preserver, you have one of the most stable forms of photography ever made. Following the introduction of ambrotypes and tintypes in the mid 1850's few daguerreotypes were produced after 1856. Most daguerreotype images are portraits.
