DR. TOM ISBILL - PROGRAM AUGUST 9TH

Metro Camera Club is pleased to announce Dr. Tom Isbill, Cr.Photog., PPA Certified, will present a program for our August 9th meeting. Dr. Isbill has been a professional photographer since 1954. Within two years he won four national awards from Boy's Life magazine for his photography and at the age of 19 began teaching photography at the college level. He now teaches photography and is Director of the Photography Instructional Labs in the Journalism Department of the University of Central Oklahoma, Edmond, Oklahoma.

He has worked in the Photographic, Print and Electronic Media. Isbill is Past-President of the Professional Photographers of Oklahoma and Past-Chairman of the Oklahoma Certification Commission. He has also been involved in civic organizations as President of two different Kiwanis Clubs, Lt. Governor-Division 19 and served on the Governor's staff of the Texas-Oklahoma District.

Tom is a former TV-Photojournalist with KOCO-TV, where he covered local effects of the President Kennedy assassination, among other local, state, regional and national events. He is certified by the Professional Photographers of America (CPP), and also holds their Photographic Craftsman Degree (Cr.Photog.). He is President of TIP Enterprises, Inc, a photographic studio, and creates Wedding, Commercial and Portrait images for a variety of clients.

Before Dr. Isbill joined the UCO staff he had been the Project Manager for Audio/Visual services at the state's largest military installation, Tinker Air Force Base, where he worked on classified material involving the Gulf War and other related events. In addition he did extensive work with the State Medical Examiner after the 1995 Oklahoma City Bombing, and was Official Photographer for the State of Oklahoma, Military Department.

Tom and his wife of 44 years, Patricia, have two sons and four grandchildren. They love to travel and spend time with their family whenever possible.
