Members may submit prints to Dennis Burian by the end of the September 10th meeting for consideration to be shown. The available space in the museum is limited and can accommodate only 40 to 45 prints depending on the mix of formats of the prints chosen to be shown.

Prints will be chosen by members of the Executive Board. Every effort will be made to represent as many club members as possible in this exhibition.

Members may submit up to two black and white and/or two color prints for consideration.

Accepted print sizes:

8 X 10 / 8½ X 11 / 11 X 14.

Prints chosen to be shown will be matted in 16 X 20 mats. A charge of \$5.00 will be made for each accepted print to offset the cost of mats, board and hardware.
