### KIM BAKER

Our program on **October 13<sup>th</sup>** when **Kim Baker** will present a **Nature and Landscape** photography program, is a **don't miss event!** A native of Oklahoma and raised in nearby Shawnee, Kim and her husband now reside in southwest Lincoln County. Baker's photography has appeared in newspapers, books and magazines, including **Oklahoma Today** and **Outdoor Oklahoma**. Her nature and landscape photography has been shown at the **Texas Art Museum** and at the **Oklahoma Christian University** and at metro galleries.

Although Kim has enjoyed the opportunity of photographing many locations across the United States and abroad, she says her decision to focus in-depth on her native state wasn't a result of necessity, but rather from a profound appreciation of all things Oklahoma. **"I love Oklahoma," Kim says. "This state offers an incredible amount of diversity for the nature photographer. We've got pine and hardwood covered mountains, mesas, clear, rocky rivers, high desert, grasslands, cypress swamps, sand dunes, and lots of public land."**

In 2001 Kim launched her web site, **Oklahoma Travel and Nature Photography**, in an effort to promote her work as well as to help raise awareness about Oklahoma and how important it is to preserve its natural areas. Some of her nature photography focuses on at-risk or otherwise endangered areas, and through this effort she has been fortunate to work with groups like the Sierra Club and the Nature Conservancy.

A series of Kim's work entitled, **"Oklahoma Rivers"**, will be on exhibition at the State Capitol later in the year.
