



Camera Club Founder Dr. John Hill

John Hill began his professional career as a school teacher in the Fort Worth area and received his Ed.D from the University of North Texas in 1970. He then taught at McMurry University in Abilene, Texas, Indiana University Northwest, in Gary, Indiana, and Southern Nazarene University in Bethany, Oklahoma. He completed his ten year university teaching at The University of Texas at Pan American in Edinburg, Texas in 1981.

He moved to Fort Worth in 1983 where he served as an Educational Consultant for the next nineteen years. While at Region XI he worked as a video producer for five years and produced over 200 educational videos. The videos spanned many aspects of education from effective teaching practices to school bond elections. He also produced a video for state wide distribution for which the initial order was 7,800 copies. Also, every teacher was required to watch the video and sign off on it. The video dealt with issues in the state wide Special Education Program. John and his video editor won the Crystal Award for *The Best Educational Video* in 1998. It was awarded by the Texas School Public Relations Association in Austin, Texas.

He is now retired and has been married to his lovely wife June for 43 years. He and June have two grown children, Karen Hill-Garrett, M.D. (Internist) who practices in the Intermountain Medical Group in Salt Lake City, Utah. His son, Brian Hill is a hotel Senior Area Manager for the Intercontinental Hotel Group and oversees forty two Holiday Inn Express hotels in Texas.
