

## Monthly Photo Tip – Christmas Lights

- 1. Set you aperture to a low open setting (i.e. f/2.8 to f/4.5).
- 2. Use a tripod. Since it is low light, you will get a steadier image with a tripod.
- Use an iSO of 400 800 depending on how well your camera can handle noise (or for those using film grain).
- 4. Set your exposure to manual or make sure you are in aperture priority and check your over/under setting to make the scene remain dark (i.e. set your camera to underexposure the scene so it won't make all the black areas gray).
- Set your shutter speed to adjust for exposure if using manual setting and start around 1/50<sup>th</sup> of a second.
- 6. Consider shooting just after sunset when doing outdoor shots to get that dark royal blue instead of just the black of a night sky.
- 7. Consider macro shots for an interesting twist on small detailed ornaments or other decorations.
- 8. Consider a wide angle for shots of larger lit objects such as houses or buildings.
- 9. Go out and have some fun.

Check the internet for addresses and times of service for any eatery that may be of interest; and, you might want to contact other members to see if there is any interest in eating together.



On February 4, 2016, Metro Camera Club will host a Special Saturday Workshop concentrating on Portrait Lighting and Tabletop Photography.

Randy Taylor will be providing instruction for portrait lighting and posing. Club member, Janet Steyer, will again provide a huge display of tabletop set-ups demonstrating different lighting for small still-life photography. Jack DeLisle will demonstrate focus stacking techniques.

The Workshop starts at 10:00 AM (set-up people will need to be there at 8:30 AM) and continues until 3:00 PM. Joe is asking for a few volunteers to help set up the room, put out chairs and help members with bringing in equipment, etc.

A charge of \$10.00 per person for the Workshop....Pizza and drinks will be provided.

Mr. Taylor will begin portrait instruction promptly at 10:00 AM until noon. During lunch and until 3:00 PM members and guests will be encouraged to use the same equipment used during the lecture to practice the art of portrait photography provided by members of the Metro Camera Club.

Bring your camera to the Workshop. Be sure your camera is able to hook up with the studio sync cords or wireless triggers. Check with your local photo dealer or Joe Wilson for help in this area.

Models will be present and it is customary to provide courtesy photos (usually 8 x 10) or a CD for their efforts.
